

Don't be Frustrated about the Forgiveness of Allah

Assalamualaikum wa Rahmatullahi wa Barakatuhu

Today's topic is: "Don't be Frustrated about the Forgiveness of Allah

Those of us who are involved in sinful deeds, Allah makes us feel innumerable worries and discomforts in our minds. Allah (SWT) Say's it:

العَذَابِ الْأَدْنَىٰ

That is the near punishment. Allah Ta'ala reminds us of this near punishment so that we may return to Allah before committing any major sin.

It is revealed in the Holy Qur'an, : Surah As-Sajda

1) Before that major punishment I will continue to give them the taste of small punishment in this world. Maybe they will come back.

Surah 32 As Sajda, verse: 21

وَلَنذِيقَنَّهٖم مِّنَ الْعَذَابِ الْأَدْنَىٰ دُونَ الْعَذَابِ الْأَكْبَرِ لَعَلَّهُمْ

يَرْجِعُونَ ﴿٢١﴾

And we will surely let them taste the nearer punishment short of the greater punishment that perhaps they will repent.

It is revealed in the Holy Qur'an, : Surah Ar- Room

2) Disasters have occurred across the land and sea which people have achieved through their deeds so that they can understand the consequences of their deeds so that they may return.

ظَهَرَ الْفَسَادُ فِي الْبَرِّ وَالْبَحْرِ بِمَا كَسَبَتْ أَيْدِي النَّاسِ
لِيُذِيقَهُمْ بَعْضَ الَّذِي عَمِلُوا لَعَلَّهُمْ يَرْجِعُونَ ﴿٢٦﴾

Corruption has appeared throughout the land and sea by [reason of] what the hands of people have earned so He may let them taste part of [the consequence of] what they have done that perhaps they will return [to righteousness].

It is revealed in the Holy Qur'an, : Surah An-Nahl

3) The first reward of the one who repents is Jannah. Isn't that enough? But not only that, before the Hereafter, he will be happy and at peace in this life as well.

Whoever among the believers, male or female, does good, I will give him a holy and good life in the world.

مَنْ عَمِلْ صَالِحًا مِمَّنْ ذَكَرْنَا وَأَنْتِي وَهُوَ مُؤْمِنٌ فَلَنُحْيِيَنَّهٗ حَيٰوةً
طَيِّبَةً ۗ وَلَنَجْزِيَنَّهُمْ أَجْرَهُمْ بِأَحْسَنِ مَا كَانُوا يَعْمَلُونَ ﴿٩٤﴾

Whoever does righteousness, whether male or female, while he is a believer - We will surely cause him to live a good life, and We will surely give them their reward [in the Hereafter] according to the best of what they used to do.

It is revealed in the Holy Qur'an, Surah Hud

4) Ask forgiveness of your Lord, then turn to Him, and He will give you a good provision for a term appointed.

Surah 11 Hud, Verse: 3

وَأَنْ اسْتَغْفِرُوا رَبَّكُمْ ثُمَّ تُوبُوا إِلَيْهِ يُتَّعَمَّكُمْ مَتَاعًا حَسَنًا
إِلَىٰ أَجَلٍ مُّسَمًّى وَ يُؤْتِي كُلَّ ذِي فَضْلٍ فَضْلَهُ ۗ وَإِنْ تَوَلَّوْا فَإِنَّ
أَخَافُ عَلَيْكُمْ عَذَابَ يَوْمٍ كَبِيرٍ ﴿٣﴾

And [saying], "Seek forgiveness of your Lord and repent to Him, [and] He will let you enjoy a good provision for a specified term and give every doer of favor his favor. But if you turn away, then indeed, I fear for you the punishment of a great Day.

It is revealed in the Holy Qur'an, Surah An Nisa

5) He who has done wrong or wronged his soul, then seeks forgiveness from Allah, will see that Allah is Most Forgiving, Most Merciful. He is the One who accepts the repentance of His servants and removes all sins.

Surah An Nisa, verse: 110

وَمَنْ يَعْمَلْ سُوءًا أَوْ يَظْلِمْ نَفْسَهُ ثُمَّ يَسْتَغْفِرِ اللَّهَ يَجِدِ اللَّهَ
غَفُورًا رَحِيمًا ﴿١١٠﴾

And whoever does a wrong or wrongs himself but then seeks forgiveness of Allah will find Allah Forgiving and Merciful.

It is revealed in the Holy Qur'an, Surah Ash Shura

Surah 42 Ash Shurah, Verse: 25

6) He (Allah) erases all sins. The Esha prayer which has not yet been performed, is in an impure state, has also done bad deeds like zina, etc. Allah Ta'ala erases all sins, and He knows what man is doing.

وَهُوَ الَّذِي يَقْبَلُ التَّوْبَةَ عَنْ عِبَادِهِ وَيَعْفُو عَنِ السَّيِّئَاتِ وَ
يَعْلَمُ مَا تَفْعَلُونَ

And it is He who accepts repentance from his servants and pardons misdeeds, and He knows what you do.

So dear brother and sister, except those who repent and believe and do good deeds, Allah will change their evil deeds into good deeds, and Allah is Most Forgiving, Most Merciful.
