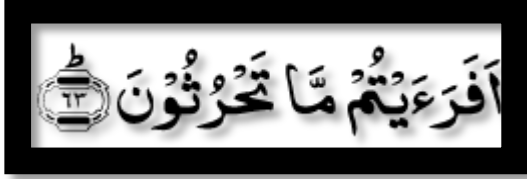


**Assalamu Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahe Wa Barakatuhu

Today's topic: "It is Allah who grows buds from the seeds"

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:63

1. And have you seen that (seed) which you sow?



See you the seed that you sow in the ground? (Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:63)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:64

2. Is it you who makes it grow, or are we the grower?



Is it ye that cause it to grow or are We the Cause? (Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:64)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:65

3. If we willed, we could make it (dry) debris and you would remain in wonder,



Were it Our Will we could crumble it to dry powder and you would be left in wonderment. (Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:65)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:66

4. (Saying), "Indeed we are (now) in debt.



(Saying) "We are indeed left with debts (for nothing): (Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:66)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:67

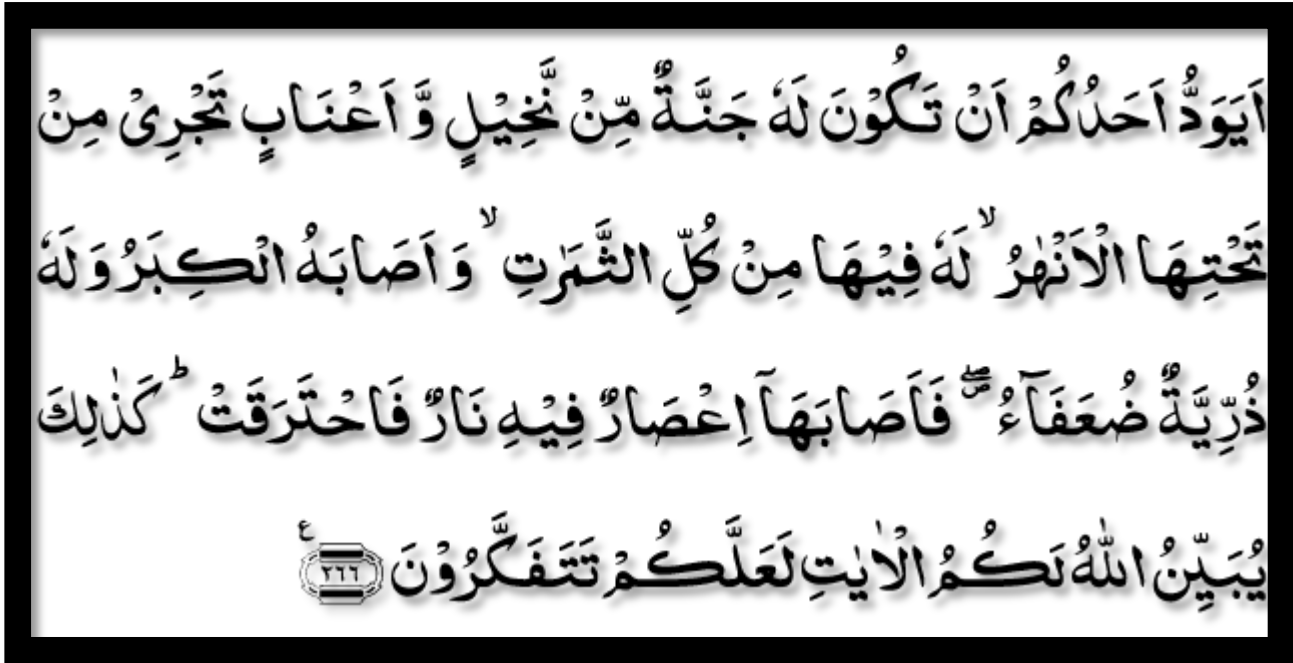
5. Rather, we have been deprived.”



"Indeed are we shut out (of the fruits of our labor)." (Sura Al Waqi'ah 56:67)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al-Baqarah 2:266

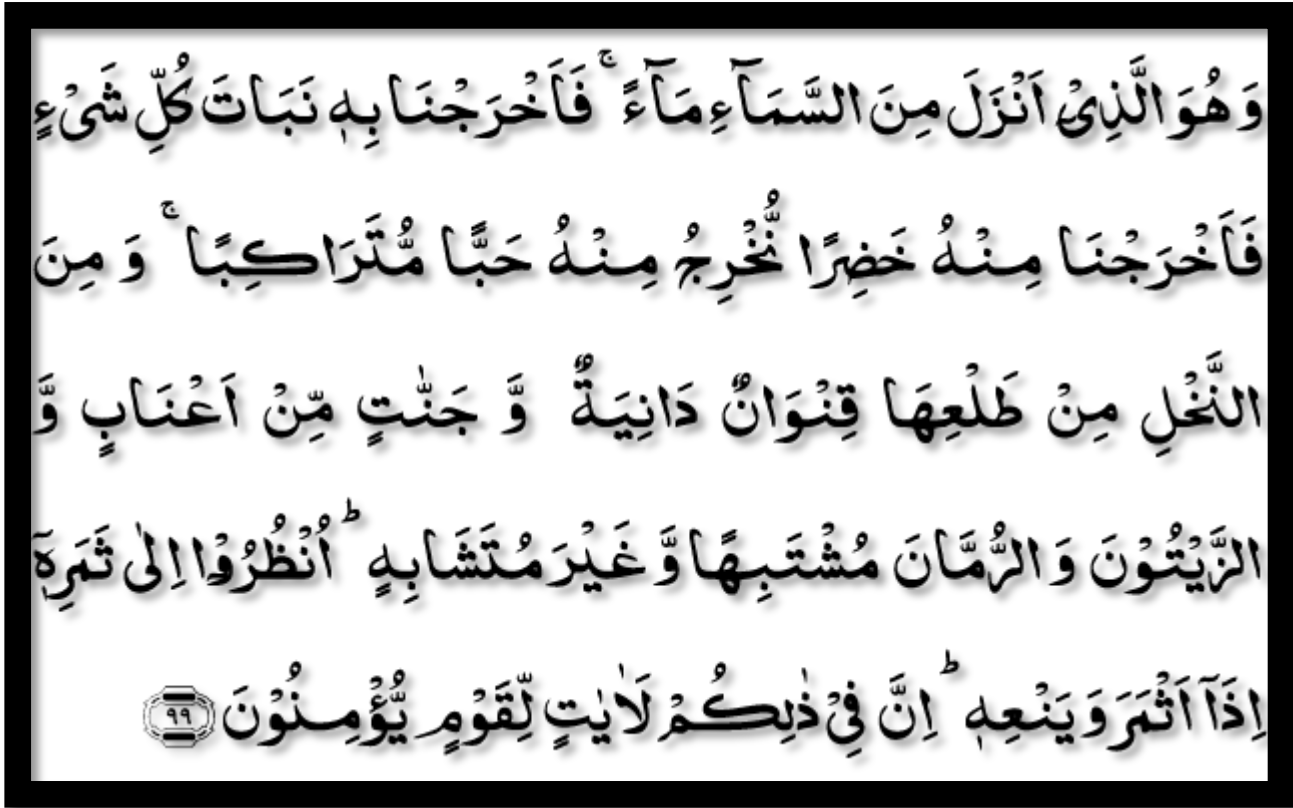
6. Would you like that your garden full of palm trees and grapevines is hit by a whirlwind containing fire and is burned?



Does any of you wish that he should have a garden with date-palms and vines and streams flowing underneath and all kinds of fruit while he is stricken with old age and his children are not strong (enough to look after themselves) that it should be caught in a whirlwind with fire therein and be burnt up? Thus, doth Allah make clear to you (His) signs; that ye may consider. (Sura Al-Baqarah 2:266)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al An'aam 6:99

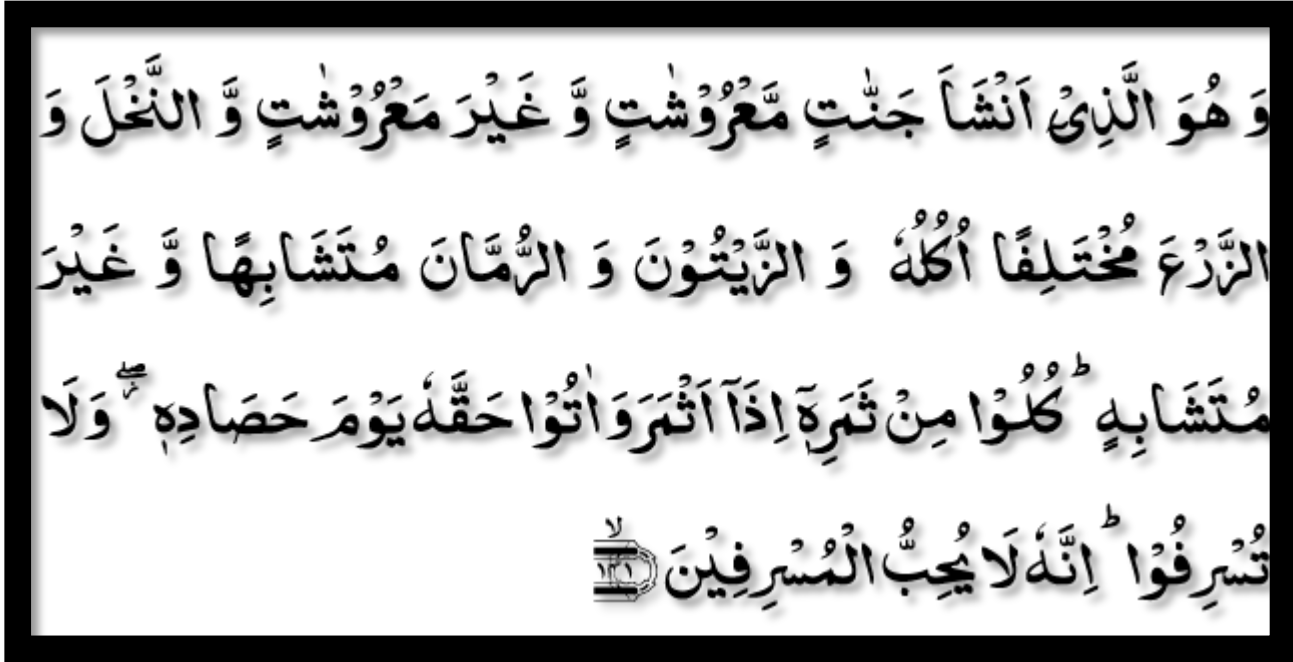
7. And it is He who sends down rain from the sky, and with it We produce thereby the growth of all things.



It is He who sends down rain from the skies: with it We produce vegetation of all kinds: from some We produce green (crops) out of which We produce grain heaped up (at harvest); out of the date-palm and its sheaths (or spathes) (come) clusters of dates hanging low and near: and (then there are) gardens of grapes and olives and pomegranates each similar (in kind) yet different (in variety): when they begin to bear fruit and the ripeness thereof. Behold! in these things there are signs for people who believe. (Sura Al-An'am 6:99)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al An'aam 6:141

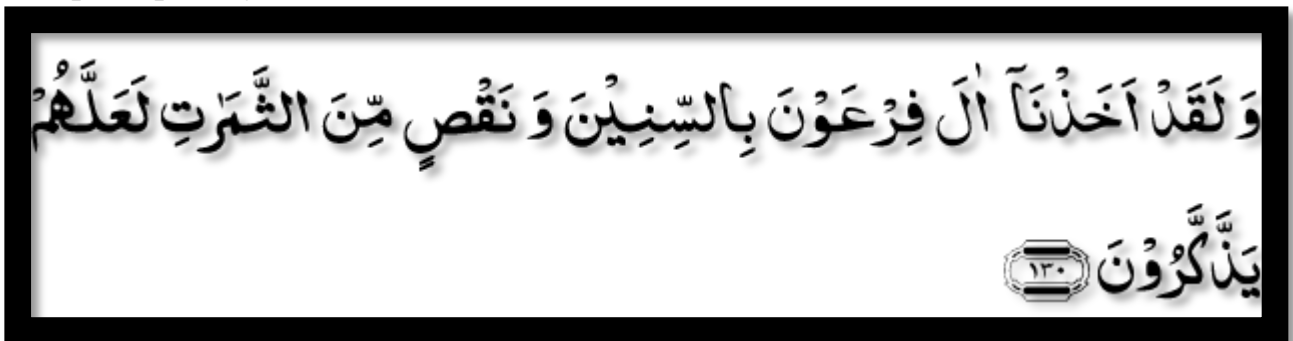
8. Eat of (each of) its fruit when it yields and give its due (Zakah) on the day of its harvest.



It is He who produceth gardens with trellises and without and dates and tilth with produce of all kinds and olives and pomegranates similar (in kind) and different (in variety): eat of their fruit in their season but render the dues that are proper on the day that the harvest is gathered. But waste not by excess: for Allah loveth not the wasters. (Sura Al-An'am 6:141)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al-Araf 7:130

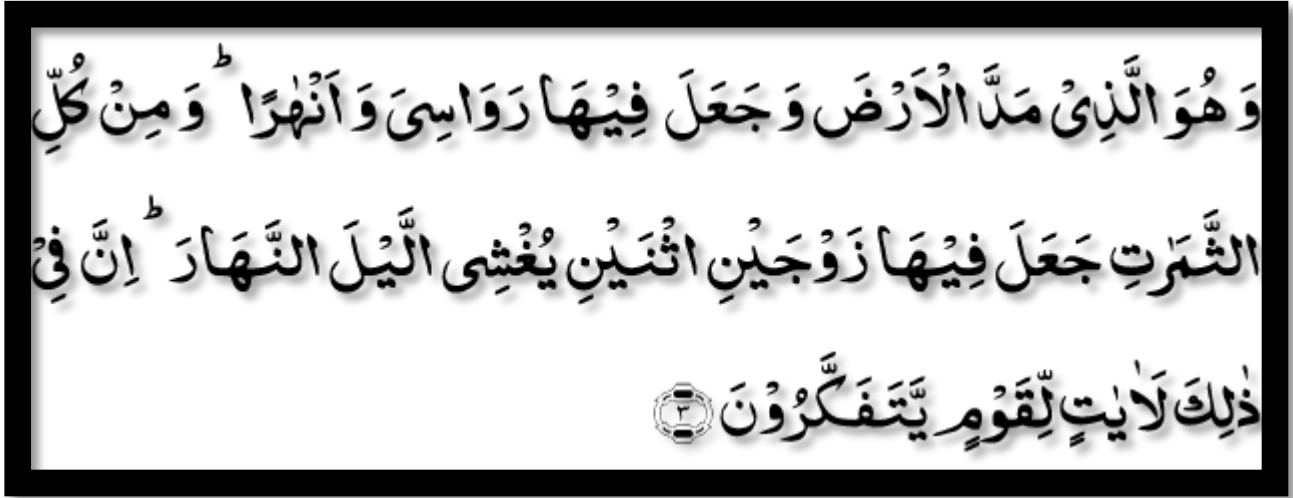
9. And we certainly seized the people of pharaoh with years of famine and a deficiency in fruit perhaps they would be reminded.



We punished the people of Pharaoh with years (of drought) and shortness of crops; that they might receive admonition. (Sura Al-Araf 7:130)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Ar-R'ad 13:3

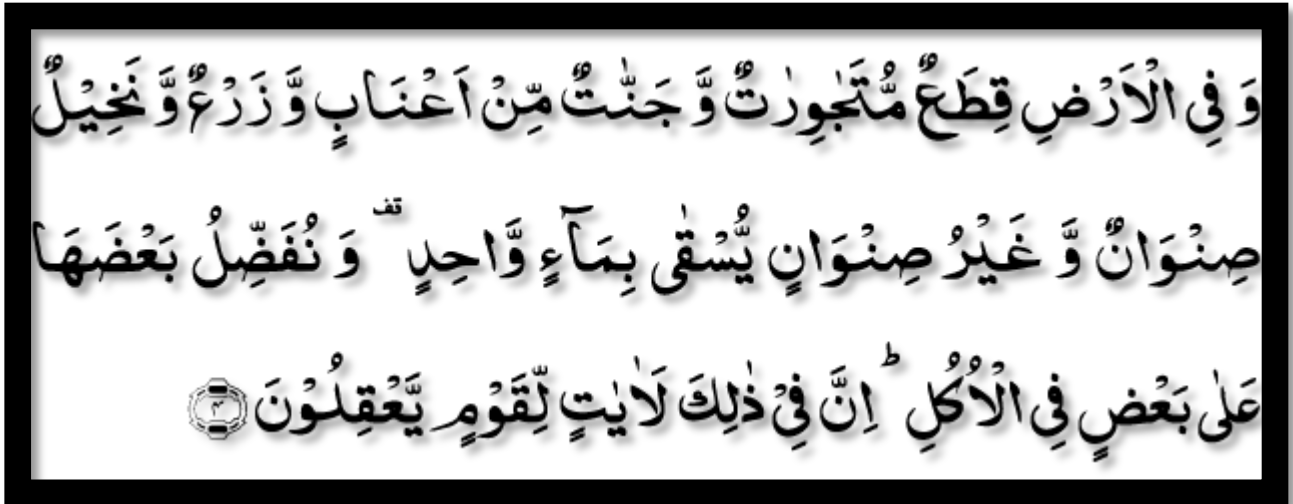
10. And from all of the fruits He made there in two mates.



And it is He Who spread out the earth and set thereon mountains standing firm and (flowing) rivers: and fruit of every kind He made in pairs two and two: He draws the Night as a veil o'er the Day. Behold verily in these things there are Signs for those who consider! (Sura Ar-R'ad 13:3)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Ar-R'ad 13:4

11. Watered with one water, but we made some of them exceed others in (quality of) fruit.



And in the earth are tracts (diverse though) neighboring and gardens of vines and fields sown with corn and palm trees growing out of single roots or otherwise: watered with the same water yet some of them We make more excellent than others to eat. Behold verily in these things there are Signs for those who understand! (Sura Ar-R'ad 13:4)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura An-Nahl 16:10,11

12. He causes to grow for you thereby the crops, olives, palm trees, grapevines and from all the fruits.



It is He Who sends down rain from the sky: from it ye drink and out of it (grows) the vegetation on which ye feed your cattle. (Sura An-Nahl 16:10)



With it He produces for you corn olives date-palms grapes and every kind of fruit: verily in this is a Sign for those who give thought. (Sura An-Nahl 16:11)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al-Kahf 18:41

13. Or its (garden's) water will become sunken (into the earth), so you would never be able to seek it.



"Or the water of the garden will run off underground so that thou wilt never be able to find it." (Sura Al-Kahf 18:41)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al-Kahf 18:45

14. We send down from the sky, and the vegetation of the earth mingles with it and (then) it becomes dry remnants, scattered by the wind.



Set forth to them the similitude of the life of this world: it is like the rain which We send down from the skies: the earth's vegetation absorbs it but soon it becomes dry stubble which the winds do scatter: it is (only) Allah Who prevails over all things. (Sura Al-Kahf 18:45)

It is revealed in the holy Quran: Sura Al-Muminun 23:18,19,20

15. And [We brought forth] a tree issuing from Mount Sinai which produces oil and food for those who eat.



And We send down water from the sky according to (due) measure and We cause it to soak in the soil; and We certainly are able to drain it off (with ease). (Sura Al-Muminun 23:18)



With it We grow for you gardens of date-palms and vines: in them have you abundant fruits: and of them you eat (and have enjoyment). (Sura Al-Muminun 23:19)



Also, a tree springing out of Mount Sinai which produces oil and relish for those who use it for food. (Sura Al-Muminun 23:20)

Dear Brother and Sister, it is Allah who grows buds from the seeds and these buds become plants and trees. And it is Allah who provides us and animals food from plants and trees.

Seed, fertile land & water are needed to grow plants and tree. Allah can destroy all these also. No rain, whirlwind, flooding, sun heat destroys the crops, fruits & plant. Man has no control over these. We must fear Allah, so that He does not destroy our food provision. We must remember Allah. Seek His Mercy by devoting to His way of life in this world.
